Construction began in August, 2013 for a new boardwalk and pet memorial area, called Buddy's Place, located in Armstrong-Kelley Park's Weston Nurseries Azalea Garden. Continuing our long tradition of 1,000+ personalized boardwalks visible throughout the park, we are pleased to announce this special initiative for our beloved pets and their owners. The Park is home to happy dogs; we see them daily-- jaunting along the many hillside trails, lying patiently under a picnic table while their owners have lunch, chasing squirrels, or taking a drink at Joy's fountain. There will be memorial river rocks engraved with dogs, cats, birds, hamsters, guinea pigs, bunnies, horses --more different pet stones than you could imagine!

You can already see the outline of the area taking shape. It's right off the green tucked behind the big holly tree. It will feature four new connecting boardwalks in a diamond shape, outlining a fenced in area featuring a sundial. The fence will enclose 6-8" natural river stones, with an image of your pet, and engraved with your personal message. Choose from a traditional boardwalk or a memorial pet stone or both! In the future, birdhouses will appear on the fences and trees, and a woodland walk will link Liam's View and Buddy's Place.
